

# City of Northglenn Water Conservation Rebate Information

## How to Apply

Compile and fill out the required documents for the water conservation rebates. Northglenn's Turf Replacement, Slow the Flow, and Garden in a Box programs are partnered through Resource Central. To learn more information about the programs, please visit Resource Central's website found [HERE](#).

## Rebate Rules

- Rebates are only available to the City of Northglenn water customers.
- Rebate applications are processed in the order in which they are received and are available while there is sufficient funding.
- Change of Address - In the event a property owner moves to a new property in Northglenn, the credit balance will be applied to the new utility account. If the property owner moves outside of Northglenn, any rebate credit will be forfeited.
- New construction does not qualify.

## Required Information

- Water Conservation Rebate Application (indicate rebates you are applying for).
- Affidavit of Legal Residency (included in the application packet).
- Copy of Legal ID.
- Copy of receipt with the item eligible for rebate highlighted or circled.
  - Applications must be sent within 365 days of the purchase date.

## For Single-Family Residential Properties:

### **Water-efficient Toilet Rebate**

- Up to \$75 per toilet.
- Limited to two (2) toilets per address every ten years.
- Residential customers must own the residence where the toilet is being replaced.
- to qualify, toilets must use 1.28 gallons of water per flush or less; dual-flush toilets with > 1.28 gpf functions will not be approved.

### **Water-Efficient Washing Machine Rebate**

- Up to \$100 for a new, high-efficiency washing machine.
- Limited to one (1) washing machine per address every ten years.
- Residential customers must own the residence where the washer is being installed.
- Washing machine must be an EPA Certified Energy Star product. Check the website before purchasing your machine to ensure you will qualify. A list of qualifying washers can be found [HERE](#).

### **Rotary Sprinkler Head Rebate**

- \$3 per sprinkler head.
- Limited to twenty-five (25) sprinkler heads per address.

### **Irrigation Timer Rebate**

- Up to \$100 per timer.
- Limited to one (1) timer per address every ten years.
- The timer must be Water Sense labeled.

### **Rain Barrel Rebate**

- Up to \$50.
- Limited to one (1) rain barrel per address every five years.

## For Commercial and Multi-Family Residences:

### **Water-efficient Toilet or Urinal Rebate**

- Up to \$75 per toilet.
- Limited to ten (10) toilets and/or urinals per address every ten years.
- Toilets must be 1.1 gallons per flush or less. Urinals must be 0.5 gallons per flush or less.
