**Free landfill day:** Saturday, May 15, and Oct. 23, 2010 from 7 a.m. to 2 p.m. at the Denver Regional Landfill. **Directions:** Take I-25 north to exit #229 (Colorado Highway 7). Go left (west) on Highway 7 to Sheridan Parkway. Turn right (north) on Sheridan Parkway and make a left at the stop sign (County Road 4). At the next stop, turn right (north) onto County Road 5. At the first intersection, turn left (west) onto County Road 6, which dead ends at the landfill. All loads to the landfill must be covered. **Proof of residency such as a driver's license and/or current utility bill is required.**
