At approximately 2:31 P.M., the Northglenn Police Department responded to a report of a Robbery occurring at the U.S. Bank, located at 10520 Melody Drive. Upon arrival they learned that a lone male entered the US Bank and approached the teller line, passed a handwritten note demanding cash without displaying any weapon, received an undisclosed amount of money, and fled the bank leaving in a northern direction on foot towards the PetSmart.

The suspect was described as either a white or Hispanic male, 40-50 years of age, approximately 5'8" to 5'11" tall, last seen wearing a long-sleeve gray t-shirt, blue jeans, tennis shoes, a ball cap, sunglasses and possibly wearing a brown wig.

This is the same description given on a similar robbery that occurred earlier this week in Northglenn and is possibly the same individual involved in several Metro area robberies. This case is currently under investigation by the Northglenn Police Department and the Rocky Mountain Safe Streets Task Force.
