This news release is a follow-up to the fatal accident, which occurred Saturday morning, March 8, 2008, at 12:11 AM, in the 11100 block of northbound I-25.

After conducting the preliminary investigation, it appears the earlier mention of road rage starting at the Pepsi Center is not accurate. It is believed the collision was unintentional. Alcohol is still suspected to be a factor in the cause of accident, but we are awaiting toxicology testing on both drivers.

The driver of the Ford Escort has been identified as Phillip Chavez of Loveland, Colorado. An adult passenger of the Ford Escort, Reyna Padilla-Chavez was treated for minor injuries and was later released.

The two teenage passengers of the Ford Escort, who were deceased on scene, have been identified as Damien Noyes, 14 years of age and his younger sister, Angel Noyes, 13 years of age, both of Loveland, Colorado.

The driver of the Chevy SUV Blazer has been identified as Glenn Ryburn of Northglenn, Colorado. He is currently in critical condition at Denver Health Medical Center.
