QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

1. PLEASE CONFIRM THAT ONE COPY OF THE PROPOSAL IN PDF FORMAT SUBMITTED TO RFP@NORTHGLENN.ORG WOULD BE SUFFICIENT.
Yes, this is correct. If the proposal is sent electronically to the rfp email, there is no need to send additional hard copies of the proposal.
2. IS A REPLY SENT CONFIRMING THAT THE FILE/PROPOSAL HAS BEEN RECEIVED BY THE CITY AT THE RFP@NORTHGLENN.ORG ADDRESS?
Generally, no, a response is not sent back. A response can be requested, but that email inbox is not generally checked until just before, or at the time of the bid deadline. Consultants can also contact the city clerk's office to confirm receipt. Please send electronic submissions, well before the deadline so that if it needs to be resent, it can still be considered.
3. WHAT IS THE FILE SIZE LIMIT FOR THE RFP@NORTHGLENN.ORG ADDRESS?

4. WILL THE SELECTED CONSULTANT HAVE ACCESS TO THE WATER RIGHTS MODEL MENTIONED IN THE 2007 IRP?
We do have a number of spreadsheets with system models in our files. We will provide as much information as we possibly can, to the selected consultant.
5. PLEASE PROVIDE A SUMMARY OF WATER RIGHTS THAT HAVE BEEN ACQUIRED OR CHANGED SINCE THE 2007 IRP.
We have changed 906-ish inches of Church Ditch water (08CW141), and we have a current change case in water court for 609 FRICO-Standley shares (18CW3007). There are an additional 4 inches of Church Water that have been acquired, but not changed.

6. WHO WILL BE ON THE SELECTION COMMITTEE?
The selection committee will be Tamara Moon, Sophie Porcelli and possibly Matt Wiederspahn.
7. WHAT ARE THE PERMIT/WDID NUMBER FOR BOTH THE TRIBUTARY AND NON-TRIBUTARY WELLS OWNED BY NORTHGLENN
The WDID numbers for the wells that were actually dug are:
LF 1 - 205098
LF4 - 205102
LF5 - 205102
LF7 - 205104
LF9 - 205106
Arapahoe #7 - 205094
We are still looking for the information for the well field along the South Platte that was mentioned in the Master Decree. We will continue looking for those permits, and provide to the selected consultant.
8. CAN THE CONTRACT BE CHANGED IF SOME TERMS ARE NOT AGREEABLE?
The City has standard contracts that are used for all consultants. A copy of the agreement was provided with the RFP documents for reference. Some small changes can be made to the terms of the contract, but in general the city's attorney does not prefer to revise the existing, standard agreements.
