QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS:

- 1. A question was received about negotiating terms and conditions of the indemnification section of the City' standard agreement.*
The policy for negotiating any changes to the standard agreement is that we will present any requests to the City Attorney after a preferred consultant has been selected.
- 2. A question was received about the RFP process and if this process is more similar to a Statement of Qualifications.*
This is an RFP process. We do not find it necessary to have an SOQ process for this project due to the scope and scale of the work. The complete requirements for responding to the RFP are included in the documents.
- 3. A question was received asking if the owner would be interested in procuring any additional services, such as a cyber security vulnerability assessment, as part of this project.*
The scope of this project should include only the work that is necessary to complete Northglenn's obligations under the AWIA.

Additions and Deletions:

1. Section IV Project Administration (page 27 of 30): delete the last bullet point beginning with "The consultant will be required to communicate..." in its entirety.
