Additional Site Visit

It was requested by various persons in attendance at the original site walk that we consider allowing for an additional opportunity for measurement purposes. Based on these requests, we will allow for this opportunity. We will schedule Monday, May 22, 2023 between 1:00 pm and 3:00 pm as an "open house", meaning you can drop in any time in-between those hours. This is voluntary and open to any firm wishing to walk the facility again.

Since Terracon could not distinguish this compound material from the rest of the CMU block filler in the Theater, Gymnasium and Pool areas, the block filler in these areas is considered by Terracon to be a homogeneous asbestos-containing material. Estimate of foundation depth of building excluding stage basement area is approximately 2-2.5 feet with a length of about 1,175 feet for a total of approximately 2,938 SF

Estimate of foundation depth of building stage basement area is approximately 8 feet with a length of about 108 feet for a total of approximately 864 SF

Estimate of foundation sealant is approximately 3,800 SF

The handball/racquetball court section of building (addition) appears to be with footers and foundation at grade. No sealant was observed during inspection for this part of the building.
