

The City of Northglenn Off-Leash Ordinance states:

(1) The dog is at a City-designated off-leash dog park; or (2) The dog is at a City-approved off-leash special event located on City property. These events include by way of example, but are not limited to; dog obedience classes, dog agility competitions, and Frisbee dog exhibitions. A dog may be off-leash at such an event subject to the following:

(A) The dog must be within voice and sight control of the owner or keeper at all times in such a manner so as not to endanger persons or property.

(B) The organizer of such an off-leash special event shall obtain a permit from the Parks and Recreation Board. The permit will specify the location of the event, the date and time of the event, and the amount of human and dog participants permitted.

The Parks and Recreation Advisory Board must review applications prior to vending. The Board meets on the second Thursday of each month.
