Block Party Trailer Available for Northglenn Residents *Open for Weekend Use*

Northglenn, CO – The City of Northglenn is now offering its Block Party Trailer to help city residents hold public neighborhood get-togethers.

The trailer includes all of the essentials to host a block party:

- Street barricades
- 12 tables
- 32 folding chairs
- Four ice chests and three water coolers
- Four pop-up canopy tents
- Variety of lawn games

Northglenn residents can go to www.northglenn.org/blockparty to rent the trailer. A schedule shows which weekends are available and a map displays which streets are eligible to host a party.

If everything checks out, interested residents can download and fill out the application, which requires signatures from 80 percent of residents in the neighborhood.

Once everything is approved, city staff will drop off the trailer on the Friday afternoon prior to the party, and then pick it up on Monday.

“When neighbors have a chance to get to know each other, they find out there’s more commonality and more collective purpose in what they do,” said Neighborhood Services Supervisor Tom Carlson.
