

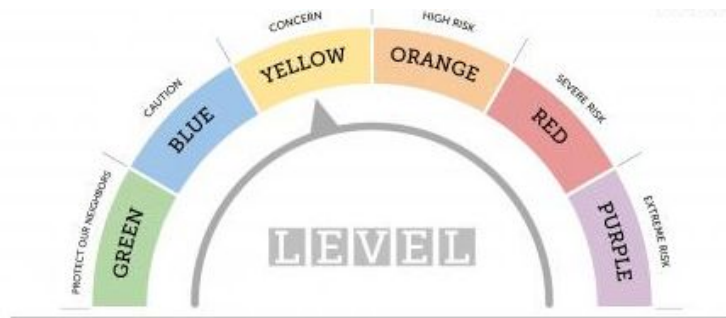

What Does Dial 3.0 Mean for Your Business?

Dial 3.0 went into effect on March 24 and you may wonder how this applies to your businesses. Here is a quick summary.

The biggest changes were in the metrics making it easier for counties to move the lower levels on the dial. However, Adams County remains in **Level Yellow** at this time. Restrictions for all the levels can be viewed [here](#).



Restaurants and gyms that have applied and been approved for the [Adams County 5 Star Certification](#) program, can operate at 100% capacity if 6 feet of social distancing can be implemented. Indoor events can operate at 50% or 225 people (seated events) or 175 people (unseated events) whichever is less.

The statewide mask mandate expires on April 3. At that point, the Governor will announce decisions on any changes. Please note the **Tri-County Health Department [mask mandate](#), for both indoors and outdoors, is still in effect and at this time does not have an expiration date.**
