Minimum Wage Increase Jan. 1

On January 1, 2019 the State of Colorado, along with 19 other states, increased the minimum wage. In Colorado the minimum wage increased from \$10.20 to \$11.10 per hour. For tipped employees the minimum wage will increase from \$7.18 to \$8.08 per hour. Source: Brock and Company
