



## Facts to Know Traffic Calming Policy

The following steps should be followed as a part of the Northglenn Traffic Calming Policy:

1. Resident completes and submits an application for Traffic Calming.
2. The Engineering Division will collect data to complete an engineering traffic analysis. This analysis will use current traffic data to confirm whether or not the neighborhood roadway system meets the threshold criteria for traffic calming measures.
3. If the thresholds are not met, but there is still a traffic concern, Basic Traffic Calming can be applied. If there is not a traffic safety issue, no action will be taken.
4. If all of the thresholds are met, the applicant is then provided a petition and a map to circulate in the neighborhood. The map will provide an area of homes that would be affected by traffic calming. A minimum of 75% of the study area must be in favor of Comprehensive Traffic Calming.
5. Once the required signatures are collected and returned to the Engineering Division, comprehensive traffic calming would then be investigated. A neighborhood meeting will be held to discuss the findings of the traffic study, traffic calming options, next steps for design and funding.
