Northglenn Mayor Pro Tem Carol Dodge Elected CML Board Vice-President

(Northglenn, CO) Carol Dodge, Ward I City Council member and Northglenn mayor pro tem, was elected vice-president of the Colorado Municipal League (CML) board of directors for 2016-17 at the 94rd Annual CML conference held June 21-24 in Vail, CO. This is Dodge's second senior board position, she served as CML board secretary treasurer during 2015-16.

Dodge was elected to her first term on the Northglenn City Council in 2009 and won reelection in 2013 for her current second term, in which she is serving as mayor pro tem. She has owned and operated a successful small business, Dodge Sign Co., in Northglenn for more than 20 years. Dodge currently serves as council liaison to the Northglenn Youth Commission, the Northglenn Senior Organization, and the Northglenn Arts and Humanities Foundation. She has also been on the CML Policy Committee since 2009.
