Citizens Police Academy offered by Northglenn Police Department

Class starts March 2, register today!

(Northglenn, CO) Have you ever wanted to know what Northglenn Police Officers do on a day-to-day basis? Find out as the department invites the community to sign up for its free Citizens Police Academy. City officers and other members of the law enforcement community will teach 12 weekly sessions. Participants will gain a working knowledge of the daily activities of officers and better understand how and why they make the decisions they do.

Those attending will learn about: community policing; patrol duties; Adams County Communication Dispatch; DUI and field sobriety tests; accident investigations; school officer assignments; technology crimes; officer safety; Crime Scene Investigation; and much more.

Participants must be 18 years of age or older and be a resident or an employee of the city of Northglenn.

The class starts Wednesday, March 2 and will be held on 12 consecutive Wednesdays from 6 – 9 p.m. at the Northglenn Police Department.

The deadline to register is Feb. 24. Applications are available at www.facebook.com/northglennpolice or www.northglenn.org/policeacademy. Register soon, class size is limited. Registrants are accepted on a first come basis.

The goal of the Citizens Police Academy is to motivate graduates of the program to continue as active partners in identifying crime and safety issues within the community and working toward solutions to those concerns. Police Academy graduates are eligible to join the Citizens Police Academy Alumni Association of Northglenn. This volunteer group stays involved with the police department by volunteering at events and participating in officer training classes.
