It's Back! Food Truck Carnival, May 12-14

25 Food Trucks each Day, Great Music, Amusement Rides

(Northglenn, CO) The Food Truck Carnival, May 12-14, will offer Denver area food trucks, carnival rides and Americana and bluegrass music. Located behind City Hall on the southeast corner of I-25 and 120th Ave., the Food Truck carnival was a big success in 2016 drawing over 30,000 guests. This year there will be 25 food trucks each day, 12 bands on two stages, and the amusement rides. Entrance to the Food Truck carnival is free. Parking is also free, but limited. Guests are encouraged to ride their bike or walk in, or park at the Wagon Road RTD Park-n-Ride and walk through the underpass (an eight minute walk) to the event. Disabled parking is available at City Hall.

Hours of the Food Truck Carnival are Friday, May 12, 3:00 p.m.-10:00 p.m.; Saturday, May 13, 11:00 a.m.-10:00 p.m., and Sunday, May 14, 11:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m.
