Water Efficiency Rebates Available for Northglenn Residents

What's that flushing sound? Water – and money – going down the drain if you don't have a low-volume toilet or high-efficiency washing machine. To encourage Northglenn residents to upgrade their appliances, the City of Northglenn is offering a rebate of \$75 for toilets and \$100 for washing machines if you replace a high-water use appliance with a high-efficiency model.
