## Open House for Possible New Rec Center

**Jan. 25, 2018** – Residents and patrons of the Northglenn Recreation Center are invited to an open house to look at updates for a proposed new facility and provide feedback.

The city is considering whether to build a new rec center/theater/senior center on the plot directly west of the City Hall parking lot, 11701 Community Center Drive.

Residents were invited to give feedback last fall. Staff and the advisory committee used that information to develop a proposed concept plan. At the second open house, we'd like to know if we got it right.

The open house is 5-8 p.m. Tues., Feb. 13 at the rec center, 11801 Community Center Drive.
